Listen to the lyrical sounds of the Chinese *guqin* (Chinese 7 string zither) and *xiao* (Chinese vertical bamboo flute) as played by a recognized master performer and teacher Li Xiangting. Li will be accompanied by Wang Fei on guqin as well as *guzheng* (another type of traditional Chinese zither with 24 to 26 strings). The guqin held an important place in imperial China as one of the four traditional activities practiced by the scholarly elite. Li is Distinguished Professor at the Central Conservatory of Music in Beijing. Wang is director of the North American Guqin Association (NAGA).
